

Welcome to our home...

Woodsaws Farm is a working, family-run farm, spread across 180 acres, with 10 acres of woodland and a small orchard, planted in 2005. The barns were originally built in 1867 and were used as cow stalls and a mill, which crushed corn, and a milking parlour which was added at a later date. The farmhouse was built 100-150 years prior to the barns and has been extended on throughout its' life.



The Wills family moved to Woodsaws in 1997. In 2000, work started on converting the barns into purpose-built properties. No easy feat, but in two years they had created four separate properties; The Parlour, built from the old milking parlour, Rumsdale, named after the woodlands on the land, The Mill, as the property contains a working part of the old mill, and a private property used by the owners. The Parlour and Rumsdale are now privately let too.

At Woodsaws, we have a large cattle herd, with one pedigree Limousin bull. We ask you don't enter fields with the bull as he can be quite short tempered. As lovely as Cornwall is, we don't think visiting the hospital is on your list. Chickens, sheep donkeys, horses, dogs and cats, can all be found here at Woodsaws. Although we are happy for you to interact with the animals, please remember they are working animals, not pets, and should be treated accordingly. Dogs should be kept on a leash and children must be supervised at all times.



Woodsaws is in an idyllic location, and not just because it's hidden away down a private road. Looe and Polperro are minutes from here, with Bodinnick ferry down the road taking you to Fowey and further into Cornwall. Lanreath is our closest village and boasts beautiful historic buildings, as well as having a Post Office and small community shop.
